




Helpful Hints:

- Introduction - State your point. What do you want to have happen. Be clear.
- Reasons - Give three reasons why the reader should take your side or position. Make sure you explain in detail why this is a good idea and the benefits.
- Conclusion - Restate your position or point. Remind the reader what you want to happen. End with a call to action.

Helpful Hints:

- O - State your opinion. Tell how you feel about the topic.
- R - Give reasons. Tell your readers WHY you feel that way.
- E - Give Examples. Share 2-3 examples that support the why. Use "because" give details.
- O - Restate your opinion in a different way. Tell how you feel one more time.
