Fun Addition To Journals!

Acrostic

An acrostic poem is a fun poem that uses the first letter of every line to spell a word down the left side of the poem.

Characteristics of Acrostic Poems

- An acrostic poem can be written about anything
- Each acrostic poem has a "theme" word that runs down the left side of the poem.
- Each line can be one word that describes the "theme" word.
- Each line can also be written so it connects to the next in more of a lyrical way.

Radiant is each and every bloom



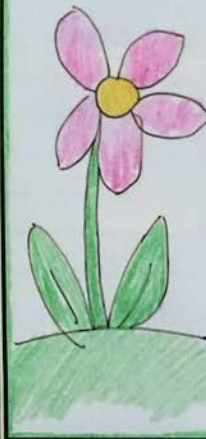

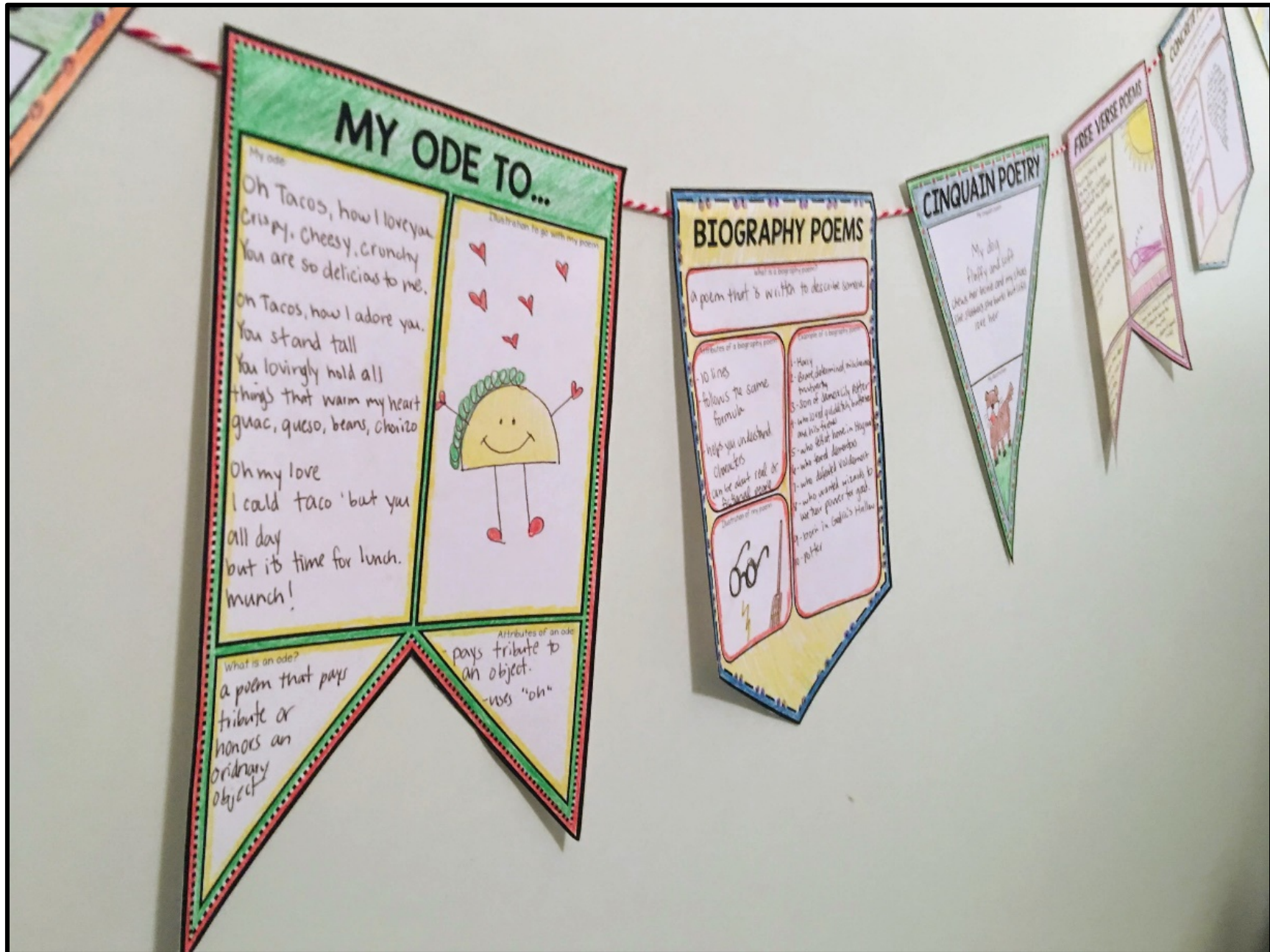

Poetry can be written in a variety of forms. Poems are usually written to express emotions, feelings, or deep thoughts.

Characteristics of a Poem

- ❖ Poems are written in lines and stanzas
- ❖ Poems are written in a specific form (narrative, free verse, haiku, limerick)
- ❖ Poems often have a rhyme scheme, but they don't all have to rhyme
- ❖ Poems include figurative language and other descriptive words to create imagery and evoke emotions and feelings

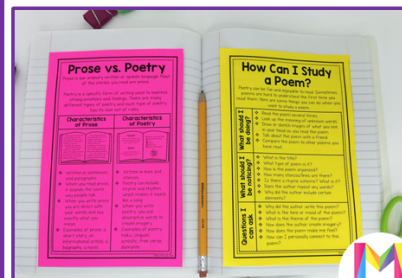
Why do we write poetry?

Authors write poems for a variety of reasons. Authors might want to entertain their readers. Poetry can also be a creative outlet for writers and give them a way to express their deep thoughts or feelings.

Why do we read poetry?

People read poetry for a variety of reasons. Readers might want to read something silly or humorous, or they might want to be challenged so they read a poem that has a deep or hidden theme that they have to think about.
