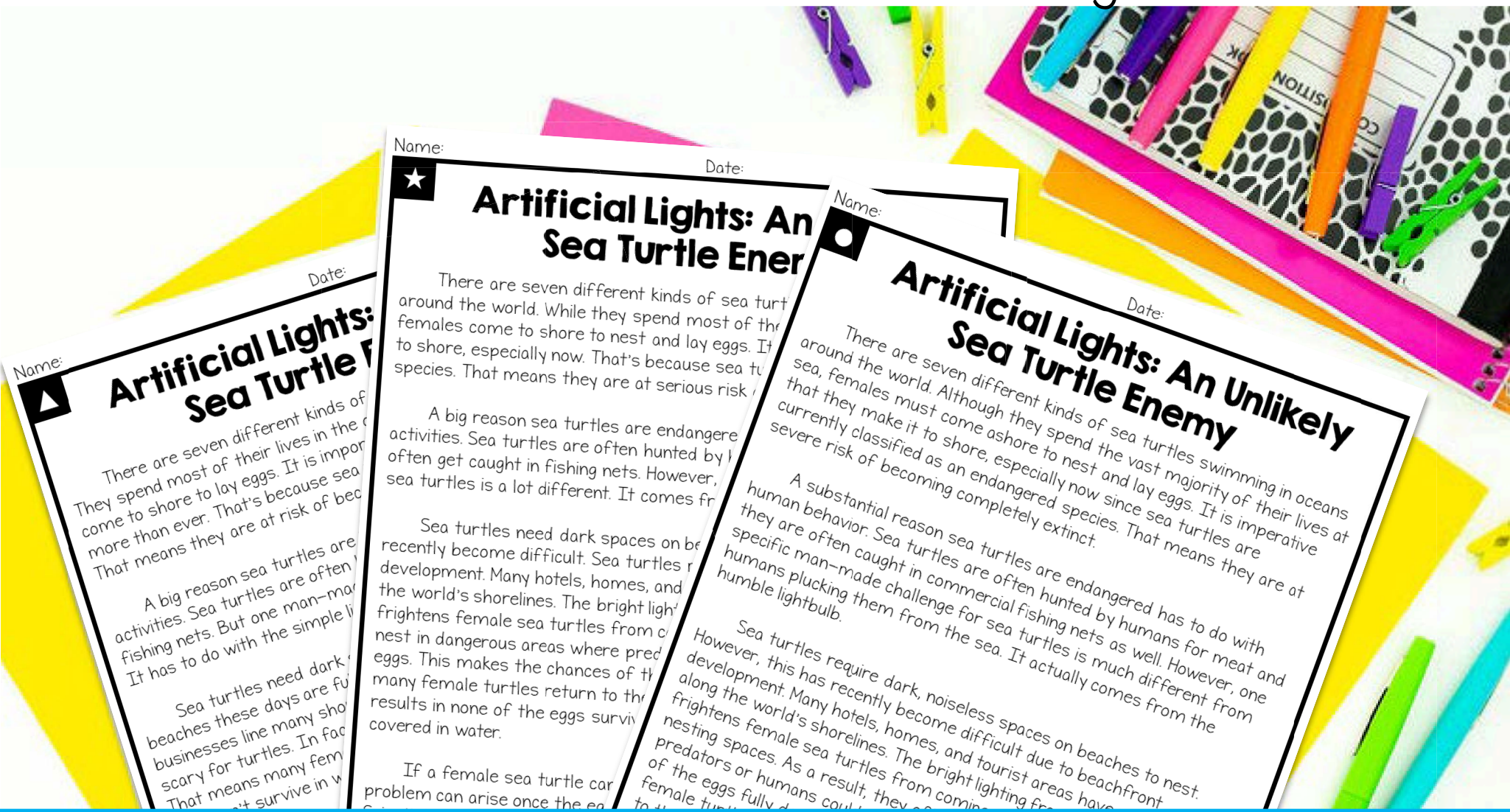

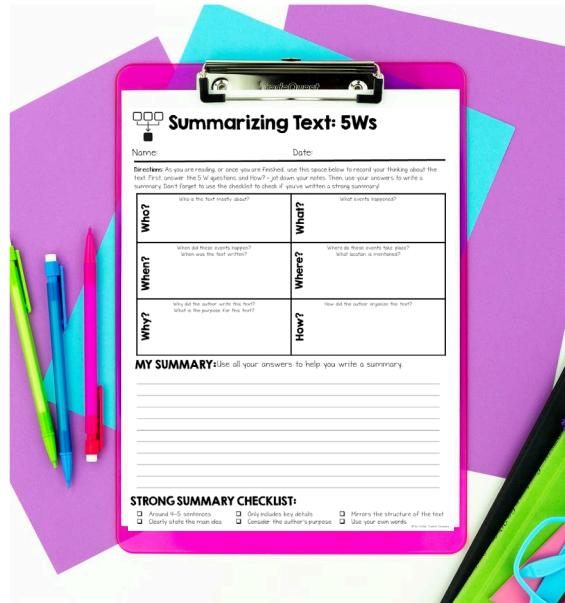

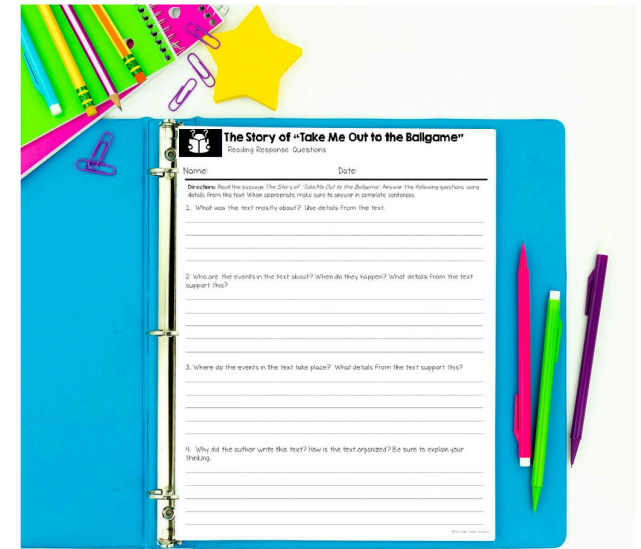

Each text has a graphic organizer students can use in response to that story, OR, it can be used with any text to practice the same skill.



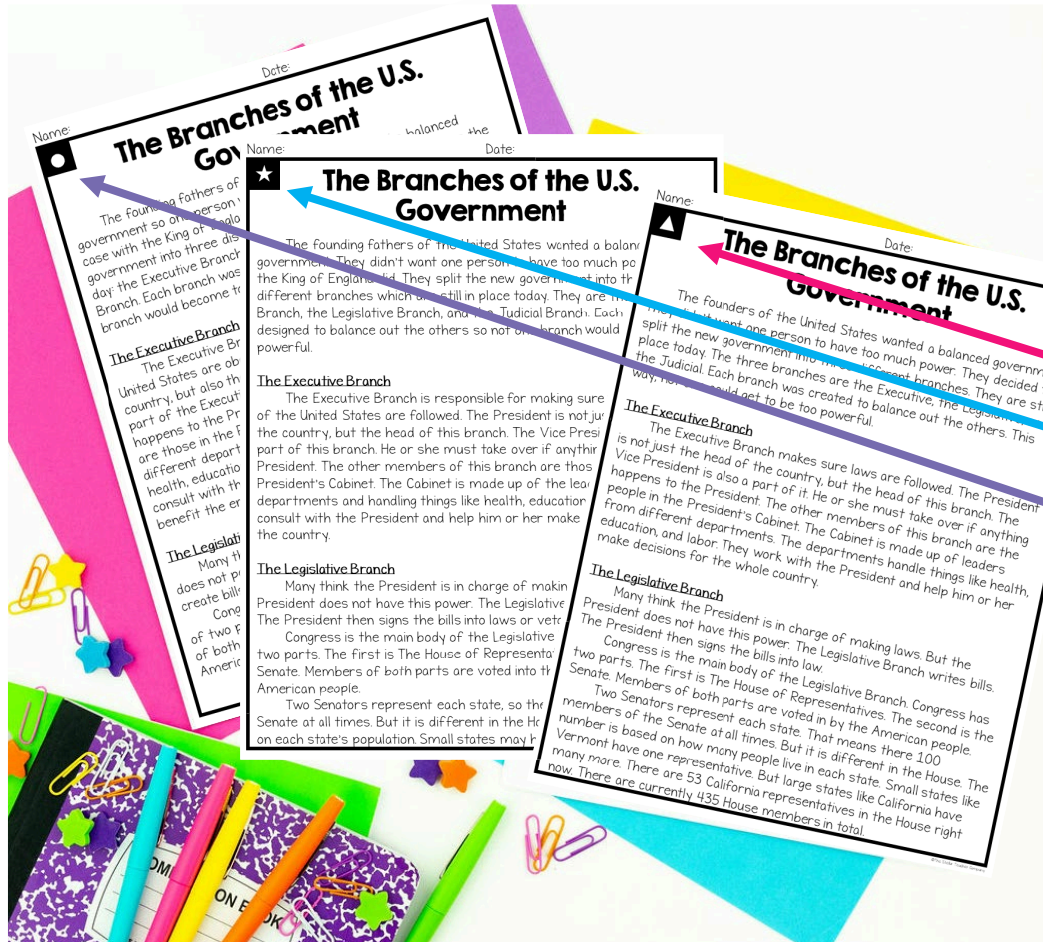
