An extreme exaggeration that is not meant to be taken literally.

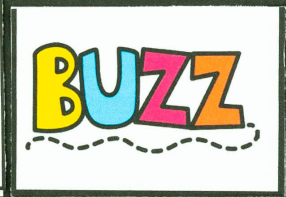


I'm so hungry, I could eat a horse.
