

## The front of each interactive grammar trifold provides students with a space to write down important information about that skill.






The inside of the trifold provides students with worksheet like practice.

It also includes at least one open-ended question about that skill.



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
The back of the trifold provides students with a creative choice board.


They are given a set of tasks that allow them to creativly demonstrate their understanding of the skill.
